Annunziata (Nancy) Dattola is Researcher at the Department of Dermatology, University of La Sapienza in Rome, chairman Prof. Giovanni Pellacani (Italy).

Her main field of interest is the diagnosis and treatment of inflammatory skin diseases.

In 2013, she completed a two-years fellowship at the Laboratory for Investigative Dermatology at the Rockefeller University, New York, NY. During her fellowship, she focused on psoriasis, metabolic syndrome and imaging such as PET/CT, sono-elastography and CT angiography, in the diagnosis of psoriatic patients.

In January 2021, she completed her PhD in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology with a thesis entitled: "Results of two different biological treatments in patients with PsO and PsA, and detection of early arthritis".

Her current research includes projects on biological agents for the treatment of psoriasis, laser and cosmetology. She is also involved in numerous phase III clinical trials and is author of many papers on this topic.

She completed 3 years of research at the University of Rome Tor Vergata from 2018 to 2021. She was resident at the University of "Rome Tor Vergata" from 2012 to 2017.

She is member of the "Italian task force" for women with psoriasis, member of the Italian Society of Dermatology and Venereology (SIDeMaST), member of the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology (EADV) and member of the local organizing committee for the World Congress of Dermatology 2019 Milan, Italy.
